

Visa options for business conferences, seminars, trade fairs and expos

This table provides a quick reference guide to the type of visa you may be eligible to apply for. Please refer to the information on the Department's website **www.homeaffairs.gov.au** to ensure you apply for the most appropriate visa.

Persons/activity		Visa	Stay period
	Participant or an attendee at an event – that is: you will not be working, performing, direct selling a product or otherwise being paid to contribute. Unpaid speakers and presenters, where the event is non-ticketed or a fee has not been paid by the general public to attend - (note: costs such as travel and accommodation may be covered by the organisation).	Visitor visa	Up to 3 months at a time.
	Speaker, presenter, exhibitor, or other contributor invited to participate in an event by an Australian organisation.	Temporary Activity (subclass 408) visa Activity type: Invited Participant in an event	Up to 3 months.
	Performer or entertainer. Media personnel covering an event(s), where the production is intended for Australian audiences.	Temporary Activity (subclass 408) visa Activity type: Entertainment	Up to 2 years * Sponsorship is required for stays of more than 3 months or if you apply from within Australia.
	Media personnel covering an event(s), where the production is not intended for Australian audiences Persons who are otherwise working at an event - such as a project manager; site supervisor; or other highly specialised worker.	Temporary Work (Short Stay Specialist) (subclass 400) visa	Up to 3 months *Up to 6 months may be allowed in limited circumstances.
